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ACCC role in CDR

- Set rules
- Manage accreditation
- Manage register
- Education
- Enforcement

ACCC consultation paper on data access models for energy data

- ACCC needs to form a view on the most appropriate data access model for the energy sector.
- Consultation paper explores three models for consumers to access their data through the application of the CDR in the energy sector
- The paper focuses on a data access model for accredited data recipients (not direct consumer access to their data)

Data access models in consultation paper

1. Models

- Model 1: the AEMO centralised model
- Model 2: the AEMO gateway model
- Model 3: the economy-wide CDR model

2. Assessment criteria

- User functionality
- Reliability
- Security
- Privacy

Next steps for ACCC

- ACCC has agreed to provide a comprehensive forward work program to COAG EC in Quarter 2 of 2019 once a position has been reached on the data access model for the energy sector
- ACCC aiming to reach a position on the preferred model within the next few months
- Submissions on consultation paper

Other important issues for CDR in energy

- Complexities with respect to verification of consumer consent and consumer authentication
- CDR dispute resolution and existing state-based ombudsman schemes
- Potential application of the CDR to state government entities
