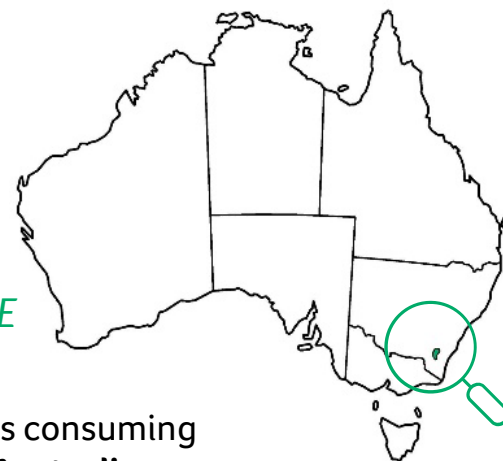


# AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY ANALYSIS OF SMALL BUSINESS RETAIL ENERGY BILLS

KEY FINDINGS FROM ENERGY CONSUMERS AUSTRALIA'S JUNE 2024 SME  
RETAIL TARIFF TRACKER REPORT



**Electricity bills** were, on average, **8% higher across Australia** for businesses consuming 20,000 kWh per annum compared to a year ago and were **13% lower in the Australian Capital Territory**. Please note, this data does not include small business energy rebates.

Meanwhile, **gas bills** were, on average, **7% higher across Australia** for businesses consuming 100 GJ compared to a year ago and were **12% higher in the Australian Capital Territory**.

## ELECTRICITY BILLS

Average annual **electricity bills** are approximately **\$7,101** for businesses consuming 20,000 kWh per annum in the Australian Capital Territory. This is a **decrease** of approximately **\$1,076** from a year ago. Please note, this data does not include small business energy rebates.

The average annual **maximum price-spread** is **\$1,465**. This is an **increase** of **\$355** from six months ago.

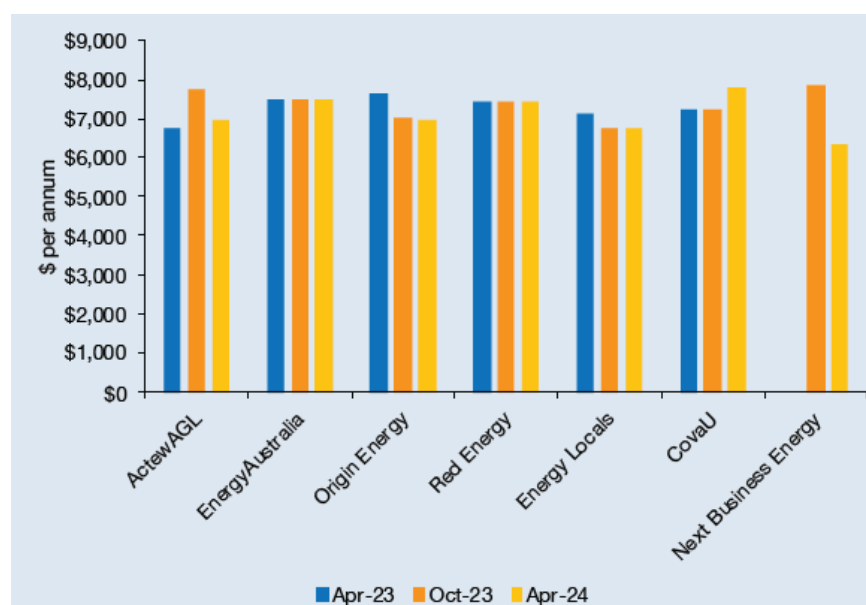


Chart 101: Annual electricity bills in the ACT, from April 2023, for SMEs using 20,000 kWh (single rate). GST inclusive.

## GAS BILLS

Average annual **gas bills** are approximately **\$4,224** for businesses consuming 100 GJ per annum in the Australian Capital Territory. This is an **increase** of approximately **\$445** from a year ago.

The average annual **maximum price-spread** is **\$2,440**. This is an **increase** of **\$755** from six months ago.

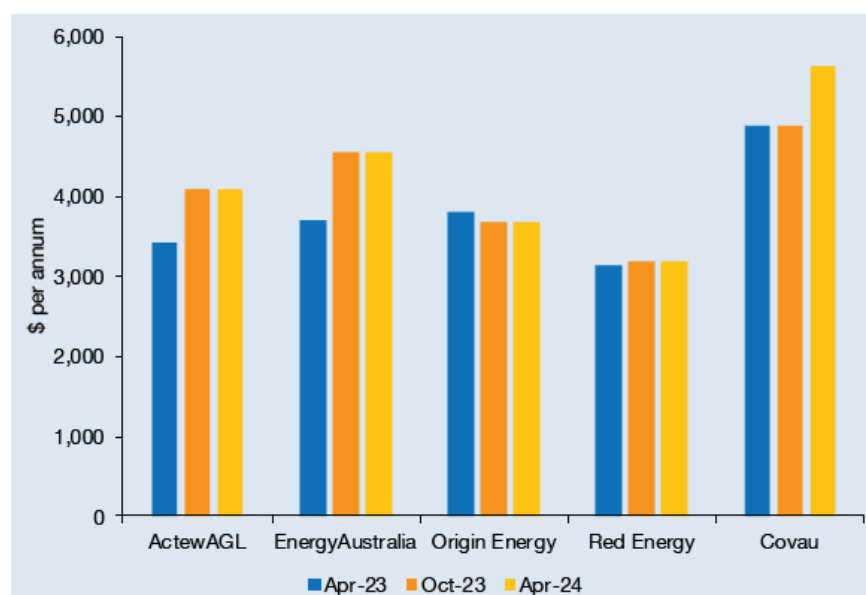


Chart 102: Annual gas bills in the ACT, from April 2023, for SMEs using 100 GJ. GST inclusive.
